The ideal candidate will have senior or graduate-level understanding of aviation business practices, hold a pilot certificate, and be capable of speaking, reading, and writing Mandarin Chinese. However, candidates who do not meet all of these criteria but who have an interest in the general aviation industry in China are encouraged to apply.

This position is currently vacant, and the term is open-ended. Office presence is not required--tasks related to this internship may be accomplished at any location. Compensation to be negotiated.
